

Community Bulletin Board Policy

The Itasca Community Library (ICL) maintains 4 Community Bulletin Boards. The bulletin boards provide organizations and businesses the ability to publicize events that are of civic, cultural, educational and recreational as well as job openings and employment training opportunities. The library does not advocate or endorse the viewpoints of any group or individual. The library welcomes a broad spectrum of opinion and a variety of viewpoints.

The library must approve all postings and may prohibit postings which do not meet library standards. The library will not post notices of partisan political groups or commercial events, activities or requests for contributions. Placement and duration of postings is at the discretion of library staff. Postings can be no larger than 11"x17". Any posting that does not have library approval will be removed.

Use of Community Bulletin Board space is free of charge.
