Contest Rules

- 1.) This contest is open to students entering first-eighth grade in Fall 2011 who either live in Itasca or attend an Itasca school.
- 2.) Designs must be original and incorporate the library's Summer Reading Club knight/medieval/fairy tale theme, "A Midsummer Knight's Read."
- 3.) Only one entry per student will be accepted.
- 4.) The deadline for entries is Monday, June 6, 2011.
- 5.) Completed entries should be taken to the Itasca Community Library's Circulation Desk.
- 6.) Winners will be selected based on originality, artistry, and use of theme.
- 7.) Copyrighted characters cannot be used. (Examples: Snoopy, Garfield, Pokemon characters)
- 8.) Winners will be notified by phone on June 13, 2011, and all entries will be displayed in the Youth Services Department beginning Monday, June 13, 2011. Each winner will also receive a small prize.
- 9.) All artwork becomes the property of the library and cannot be returned.

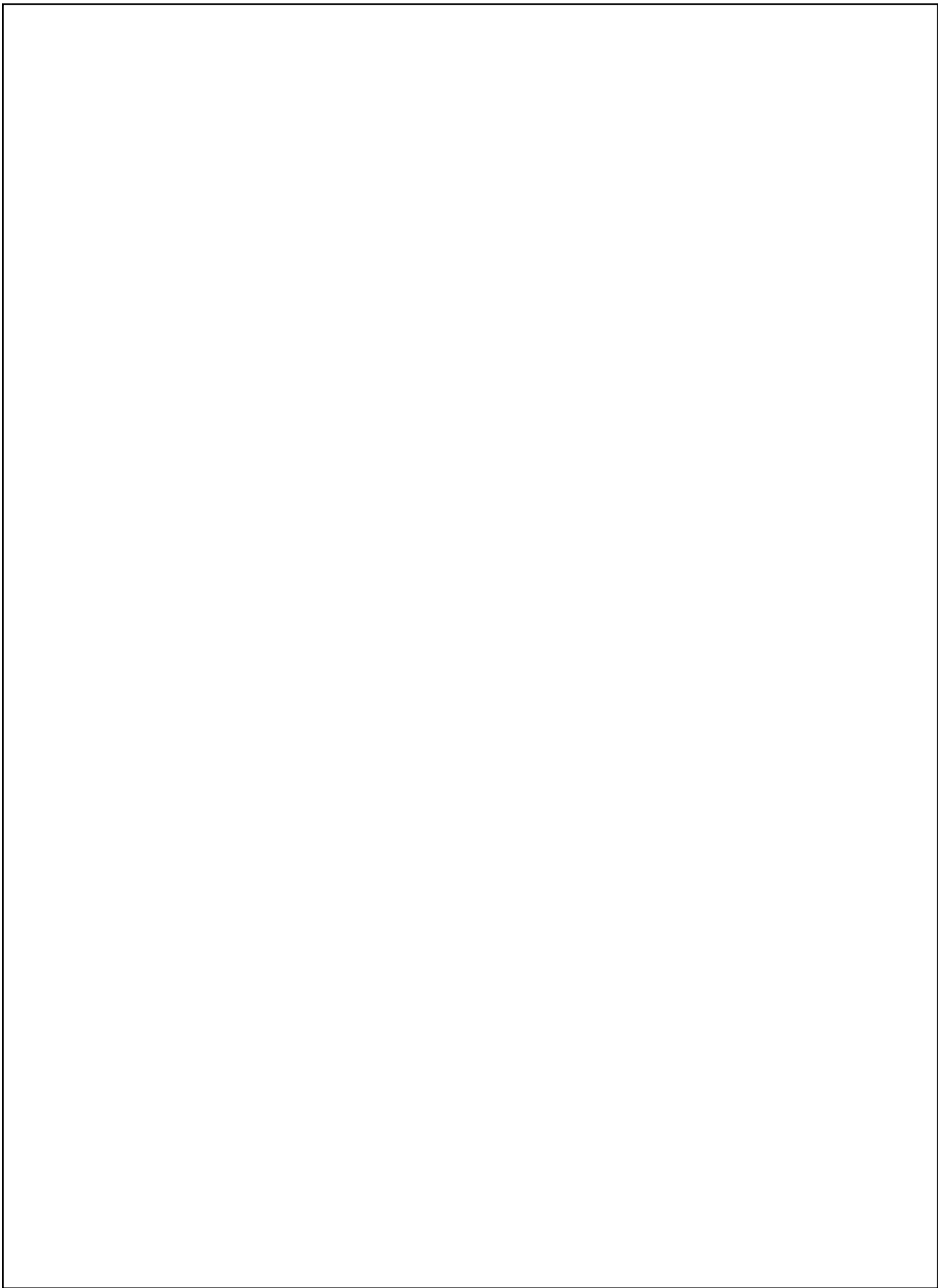
