Photography Contest



To celebrate National Library Card Sign-up Month the Itasca Community Library is calling all photographers to enter the first library photography contest. The contest is open to all Itasca library card holders.

Amateur photographers of all ages are invited to submit 1 or 2 photographs that conform to the guidelines and theme of the contest.

Guidelines:

Each contestant may enter up to two (2) black and white or color photographs. Photographs must be submitted on a CD as a jpg file or by email as a jpg file. Please include an entry form for each photo. All photos must have a title. If your photo is chosen as a finalist you will be required to have the photo printed as either an 8 x 10 or 11 x 14 picture.

Theme:

The theme is "Itasca Reads." Entries must be appropriate to the theme to be considered.

Entries must be received by September 12, 2011.

Entries will be judged by a panel and ribbons will be awarded for first place and honorable mention in the following categories:

Children (ages 13 and younger)

Adult (ages 14 and older)

Contestants will have a week to have their photo printed and returned to the library where it will be framed and displayed on the Itasca Gallery wall on the first floor.

Photographs will be returned to the contestants but digital images will be retained for inclusion on the library's permanent digital photography collection and may be used on the library web site.
