RESOLUTION MAY 2019

**A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING SMOKING
ON LIBRARY PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, the Board of Library Trustees (the Board) has control of the supervision and care of library facilities and grounds (75 ILCS 5/4-7(3)); and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that smoking and/or use of tobacco products on library property should not be allowed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board as follows:

Section 1. Prohibition. Use of tobacco products or tobacco related products is prohibited on library property. This prohibition applies to all facilities, all grounds and all vehicles. This prohibition applies to smoking, smoking products, smokeless tobacco, other forms of tobacco products, and e-cigarettes.

Section 2. Violations. Violations of this resolution shall result in:

- a. Suspension of library privileges for a period not to exceed twelve months;
- b. A fine of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$100.00 for each offense.

Section 3. Signs. Signs may be posted on library property to provide notice of said prohibition.

Section 4. Miscellaneous. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage. Any Resolutions or Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. If any part of this resolution is adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall affect only that part of this resolution specifically covered thereby and shall not affect any other provisions or parts of this resolution but shall be severable therefrom.
